CROP	APPLICATION RATE PER Hectare	REMARKS
Potatoes	4 kg	Apply at plant in the furrow.
Tomatoes	2 kg	Apply 2 weeks after transplant. Repeat during periods of active flowering. The application intervals can be shortened to 2 weeks when planting in high pH soils.
Onions	4 kg	Apply after boll initiation.
